Job Title: Technician, Level 1 or Entry Level Trainee
Department: NDT (Non-Destructive Testing)
Reports to: Supervisor

Essential Functions and Key Responsibilities:

- Responsible to the Site Level 3 Technician to perform all work with attention to detail and adherence to procedural details as set forth by manufactures guidelines and other FAA approved data
- General knowledge and skills to use and standardization of NDT equipment and materials
- Have the skills and knowledge to process parts and document results in accordance with written instructions
- Ability to read and interpret equipment manuals, written instructions, industry standards and work orders to perform required duties
- Must maintain a strong sense of responsibility and integrity to effectively perform their work
- Work closely with Certified NDT LVL 2 and/or Level 3 Inspectors to obtain the necessary on-the-job experience
- Comply with all company policies and procedures and safety requirements
- Perform other duties as assigned by Supervisor, NDT
